### 3. Relevant Authority

### 5. Implementation of Standard

Practical Implementation

The Canadian Food Inspection Agency Act provides the Agency with the authority to regulate import into or movement through Canada's territory through the *Plant Protection Act*.

Canada currently has transit requirements in place which meet the requirements of the standard.

Clarification and consolidation of Canada's transit requirements will be communicated through Plant Protection Division of CFIA policy memoranda (D-memo) as required.

The anticipated date of implementation of the standard in Canada would be when the standard is officially adopted by NAPPO.
