Consensus:	 Following a brief introduction, the ED provided a summary of the most relevant points discussed during the previous conference call: EG agreed to nominate and select a Chair and Vice-Chairperson. EG will review RSPM 38 <i>Importation of certain wooden or bamboo commodities into a NAPPO member country</i> to identify and consider points of relevance to discuss. Identify additional documents for the revision of RSPM 38 and share them with the EG Specification of the international standard for this same topic. A copy from the IPPC could not be obtained because the specification is still a work in progress. Copy of the IPPC expert working group report working on the specification.
