## **United States:**

- Planning for a press release on January 20, 2020.
- Finalizing social media calendar which will go out through the APHIS Tweeter feed and "Hungry Pest" Facebook page.
- Working with contractor in the "Plants are precious" theme.
- APHIS is working on an IYPH booth that will be in place at the National Cherry Blossom festival from March 20 to April 12 in Washington DC.
- APHIS will release the following publication materials in January.
  - IYPH article with extensive outreach tool kit (PPQ official notifications like pest alerts and other brochures).
  - o PPQ Safeguarding activities (multiple levels).
- Featured IYPH articles that will be distributed to newspapers around the country.
- Media tour (April: invasive species month). Expected several radio interviews. The media tour will also be broadcasted through the USDA radio. A Spanish version is also considered but the broadcasting source has not been determined yet.
- US social media calendar will include:
  - Invasive species awareness (February)
  - Arbor day (May)
  - Travel pathways (June)
  - National parks and recreation month Do not move firewood campaign (July)
  - Tree check month (August)
- Safeguarding 2020 conference:
  - Progress made with the conference program.

## Canada:

Consensus:	TD suggested to the EG to include an IYPH article in the next issue of the NAPPO Newsletter to be published on March 1, 2020. The options presented were to publish three separate articles (IYPH EG work, Promotion of safeguarding event in the US and the IYPH event in Mexico) or one article about the EG and the activities that will take place in the NAPPO member countries. The consensus was to publish one article. The TD indicated the article should be provided to the NAPPO Secretariat by the first week of February to allow time for translation work.
