Project:	Electronic Phytosanitary Certification			
General comments:	The meeting focused on updates regarding electronic phytosanitary certificate exchanges between countries, including progress reports, challenges with mixed commodities shipments, and system implementations. Discussions covered potential applications of artificial intelligence in phytosanitary certification and plans for the EG progress report to be presented at the upcoming NAPPO annual meeting in Ottawa. The group concluded by establishing a plan for recurring expert group meetings every four months to maintain collaboration and address ongoing developments in the field.
