Consensus:	 Significant edits were made to the document in 2015 but there is a need to clarify what was meant by "North of Shanghai" (Page 7 of RSPM 33). Justification: NZ has been using the RSPM 33 and inquired about what is meant by "North of Shanghai". Canada and the U.S. use a demarcation line set at 31° 15' N latitude. Using this reference has been useful to avoid confusion with the shipping industry. The Chairperson asked the group about their opinion to include this information in the RSPM 33.
